<b><i>What type of credit can be earned?</i></b>	Students earn both high school and college credit.	Students earn both high school and college credit. <b><i>What requirements should be met to enter these courses?</i></b>	Students must meet high school course prerequisites. <b><i>What requirements must be met to earn credit for these courses?</i></b>	Students must earn at least a B in the course and have a VoCATS score of 80 or above. Credit is awarded when the student completes the RAVE form and has successfully completed the requirements.	High School and College credit are awarded when the course is successfully completed.	College Credit is awarded when the course is successfully completed.  High School credit is only awarded if approved by the principal.
